1 The motion of plaintiff General Monitors, Inc. for a preliminary injunction came on for
2 hearing on November 4, 2016 at 9:00 a.m. in Department C16 of the Superior Court of California,
3 County of Orange, located at 700 Civic Center Drive West, Santa Ana, California 92701, the
4 Honorable James J. Di Cesare, presiding.

5 Jon Loeb of Blank Rome LLP appeared on behalf of plaintiff General Monitors, Inc. and
6 David Ward appeared on behalf of defendants Detectors Incorporated and Wing Lam.

7 Having read the motion, the memoranda, declarations and objections filed by the parties, and
8 having heard argument of counsel, and satisfactory evidence having been presented,


9 **IT IS ORDERED THAT** plaintiff General Monitors, Inc.'s motion is granted. Defendants
10 Detectors Incorporated and Wing Lam, including their employees, agents, and persons acting with
11 them or on their behalf, are enjoined and restrained as follows:

- 12 1. Defendants Detectors Incorporated and Wing Lam are enjoined from using,
13 disclosing, disseminating, distributing, or copying any information belonging to
14 General Monitors, Inc. including any formula, pattern, compilation, program, device,
15 method, technique, or process relating to the FL3100 and/or the other product that
16 Defendant Wing Lam worked on during his employment with General Monitors, Inc.
17 which is referenced in the sealed documents submitted to this Court.
- 18 2. Defendant Wing Lam is enjoined from using, disclosing, disseminating,
19 distributing, or copying any information obtained from Plaintiff in violation of his
20 Employment Agreement.
- 21 3. Defendant Lam is directed to delete the 38 documents belonging to Plaintiff
22 which are currently stored on his computer and to destroy/delete any and all copies of
23 such documents (electronic or otherwise) in his possession as well as any other
24 document belonging to Plaintiff (whether the document is in electronic form or
25 otherwise). Lam must provide Plaintiff with a Declaration, signed under penalty of
26 perjury, attesting to the required destruction no later than five days from the date of
27 this order.

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IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT plaintiff General Monitors, Inc. shall file with the Clerk of the Court an undertaking in the amount of \$10,000 pending trial of this action.
